15TH ANNUAL CIRCUS -NORTH-

This unique program is a five-day interactive circus art training for children ages 8 and up. Participants learn various circus art skills including acrobatics, juggling, stilt walking, unicycle riding, costuming, wire walking, and clowning. It wraps up with a final performance in front of family and friends showcasing their newly learned skills. 2023 will mark the 15th year of SPCAC hosting this program with our last year being 2019 and we are so incredibly excited to be reviving this program for our community.

Circus Camp is facilitated by Green Fools Theatre Society (from Calgary) who employ highly skilled circus art professionals. Their main focus is to teach circus art skills that build cooperative team spirit, which helps to develop appropriate social skills, confidence, leadership skills, and respect.

This program is inclusive to children of all developmental levels and abilities, including those on the autism spectrum disorder.

Participants learn that it is okay to be different. We have witnessed an increase in participants' self confidence as they practice self-motivation, goal setting, and interpersonal skills which are transferable to personal life and academic learning.

In consideration of SPCAC & GREEN FOOLS THEATRE offering my child, an opportunity to participate in a PHYSICAL THEATRE SCHOOL from April 8-12, 2019. I waive any and all claims I may have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue Green Fools Theatre Soc., SPCAC or School District No. 59 and/or their officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and representatives for any personal injury, death, property damage or loss of sustained as a result of my child's participation in the circus camp, arising out of any cause whatsoever, including negligence.

About 45 students from ages 8-18 will be learning various circus art skills. Green Fools Theatre employ highly-trained instructors with an absolutely clear track record of putting the safety of their students first.

The students will be supervised by 3 professional instructors, volunteers, and SPCAC staff. Basic ground rules are very clearly laid down and are strictly enforced. All students, will be expected to maintain a safe environment with minimal supervision interventions.

Accidents can be the result of the nature of the activity and can occur with or without any fault on either the part of the student or the Green Fools Theatre Instructors or the facility where the activity is taking place. By allowing your child to participate in this activity, you are accepting the risk of an accident occurring, and agree that this activity, as described above, is suitable for your child.

Participants will attend the circus camp from 4-8 p.m. from April 17-21. Participants are responsible for their own travel to and from the venue. Please supply your child with suitable equipment and clothing:
